Privacy Notice

This privacy notice covers the collection and use of information for this website, ("this website"). The "All Entrants" category runs bi-annually, and the "College Students", "Youth" and "Professional" categories run annually. All categories offer meaningful prizes and opportunities to visual artists and photo enthusiasts in general and also to students enrolled at an accredited college or university with an interest in but not limited to the Fine Arts, Liberal Arts, Journalism, Photography, or the Visual and Graphic Arts. The "College Students-Only" category is specific for students looking to enhance their prospects of building strong careers in the Creative and Visual Arts arenas'.

What information we collect and how we use it

We collect personally identifiable information that you choose to provide to us when you register for a trade show, subscribe to our magazines (either directly or through another company such as a subscription agency), sign up for email newsletters, enter a contest, or participate in surveys. During the registration process we may request certain contact information and demographic information about you such as name, mailing address, email address, company name, size of company and title. We do not sell or share this information with third parties, except as described below. We also may receive information about you from other sources and add it to the information you have provided to us. If you choose to register for a trade show or subscribe to a magazine on this website, you may also be asked to provide your credit card information to fulfill your registration or subscription request.

When we may disclose your information to others

- To send you notices for subscription renewal
- To contact you regarding marketing endeavors

In the event we are acquired by or merged with a third party entity or in the unlikely event of our bankruptcy, insolvency, reorganization, receivership, or assignment for the benefit of creditors, we reserve the right, in any of these circumstances, to transfer or assign the information we have collected as part of such merger, acquisition, sale, or other change of control.

Cookies and Web beacons

We may automatically collect non-personally identifiable information and data through the use of "cookies." Cookies are small text files a site uses to recognize repeat users, facilitate the user's ongoing access to the site and facilitate the use of the site. "Cookies" also allow a site to track usage behavior and compile site usage information that will allow for the improvement of content and target advertising.

We may also use third-party advertising companies such as Google to serve ads when you visit this website.
